Arts Crawl Food Vendors

Please Read & Follow these Guidelines

### **Food Vendors:**

- 1.** Food vendors must have a food handler's permit.
- 2.** Food vendors must have the proper City vendor's license:
  - Fixed Permanent Licensed Businesses pay a vendor's fee of \$100/year.
  - Mobile Non- permanent Vendors (without a Fixed Permanent Business License) pay \$100/14 day license.
- 3.** Prepared Food Vendors (selling prepared or pre-cooked food; without a Fixed Permanent Business License) pay \$25/day.

Please be at the City parking lot on Rt 66 between 3rd St and 4th St (next to Rex Museum) by 5:45 PM. The all trucks can move over to Coal Avenue.
